

Internship – Agricultural jobs in Denmark

Your tasks:

- You will be working within agriculture and animal care (pigs, cows, etc.) on large Danish farms
- You will be taking care of animals from birth to slaughter

We expect that you:

- Are an agricultural student/graduate
- Speak English at a communicative level
- Are between the ages of 20 to 30.
- Might have previous experience from working with animals
- Are flexible (internships start during the whole year)
- Are ready to stay abroad for 18 months (length of the internship)
- Have, if possible a driver's license

We need:

- Education plan / exam certificates in English
- Photo and CV in English
- Criminal record and Health certificate (only if you are selected for a personal interview)

Working conditions:

- 37 hours per week
- Working every 3rd - 4th weekend

Accommodation:

- Usually rooms close to the farm.
- Rent is approx. 240 Euro per month

Salary:

- Normal payment for students/ Interns is approximately 1300 Euro per month before tax.



Job description – working on a pig farm:

Farre stable

- Feeding the pigs – mostly automatically, some manual work
- Monitoring births – help during birth
- Make sure all mother pigs have the same amount of piglets to feed
- Basic treatment – grinding teeth, castration, cut tail
- Supervision and health care – injections, antibiotics (medicine course included in the internship)
- Weaning – piglets (over 7 kg) in climate stable and the mother pigs in run path
- Cleaning of stables

Climate stable

- Feeding the pigs – automatically
- Daily supervision – treatment of sick animals (eg. diarrhea, injections)
- Sort pigs by size
- Preparation for sale (at 30 kg) – help loading the pigs on to transport (early in the morning)
- Cleaning of stables

Run paths

- Feeding the pigs – automatically
- Supervision and health care
- Insemination
- Move pregnant pigs to the pregnant stable

Pregnant stable

- Feeding the pigs – automatically
- Supervision and health care
- Move to farre stable (after 100 days)

In other stables (slaughter pigs)

- Feeding the pigs – manual & automatically
- Daily supervision and health care
- Basic treatment and castration
- Cleaning the stables
- Maintain equipment
- Help load pigs to slaughter house transport
